- 2. Open ExamView Test Generator

- 4. Create A New Test Wizard
  - A. Give your exam a name
  - B. Click on Next
  - C. Highlight the question bank you want to use
  - D. Click Open
  - E. Question Bank will appear in bottom box
  - F. Click Next
  - G. Identify how many questions of each type you want on the exam
  - H. Finish and view

- 5. Create A New Test From Scratch
  - A. Give your exam a name
  - B. Click OK
  - C. Build a test from a list of options in the menu

Open CPS (Classroom Performance System) Software

- 1. Prepare Tab
  - A. Classes and Students (should already have class roster built) and choose class
  - B. Lesson and Assessment:
    - Click on your class and select New (Green Plus Sign) and choose Lesson
  - C. Name your Lesson (Math, Science, Novel Group 2 etc...)
  - D. Within the Lesson Box (second from left) click on the ADD FILES link Find your Examview Folder and choose which test(s) you want to upload.
- 2. Click on the Engage Tab
  - Select test you want to use and click on the second Engage link within the "Teach Box"
- 3. Proceed to use CPS Clickers as you normally would.
